Respective Functions of the Board of Governors

The Board of Governors draws up the admissions criteria and delegates to an Admissions Sub-Committee, which includes the Principal, the responsibility for applying these criteria.

Admissions Criteria

During the admissions procedure when applying the criteria <u>punctual applications</u> will be considered before <u>late applications</u> are considered. The application procedure opens on 9 January 2024 at 12noon (GMT) and an application submitted by the closing date of 26 January 2024 at 12noon (GMT) will be treated as a <u>punctual application</u>. An application received after 12noon (GMT) on 26 January 2024 and up to 4 pm on 31 January 2024 will be treated as a <u>late application</u>, this is also the last date and time for processing a change of preference in <u>exceptional circumstances</u>. After 4 pm on 31 January 2024 no applications will be processed until after the close of procedure on 25 April 2024.

When considering which children should be selected for admission, the Board of Governors will only take into account information which is detailed on the online application or provided directly to the school. Information provided directly to the school must have been receipted by the school. Parents/Guardians should therefore ensure that all information pertaining to their child and relevant to the school's admissions criteria is stated on the online application or provided directly to the first preference school (Information provided directly to the school must have been receipted by the school). Examples of such information include whether the child has brothers/sisters attending the school.

Priority will be given to children who will have attained compulsory school age at the time of their proposed admission, including those children whose parents deferred their admission to primary school in September 2023 as defined by the new School Age (NI) Act (both groups to be treated equally).

Priority will be given to children resident in Northern Ireland at the time of their proposed admission to the school before those who are not so resident.

If the school is over-subscribed, pupils will be admitted according to the following criteria, applied in the order set down to children of compulsory school age. Please note that compulsory school age now includes those children who had chosen to defer in the year 2023-2024.

- 1 Children with a brother/sister, half-brother/half-sister, step-brother/step-sister, foster brother/foster sister currently in attendance at Meadow Bridge. This must be stated on the application.
- 2 Children whose brother/sister, half-brother/half-sister, step-brother/step-sister, foster brother/foster sister was a former pupil of Meadow Bridge. This must be stated on the application.
- 3 Children who have a parent currently employed at Meadow Bridge. This must be stated on the application.
- 4 Other Children.

Supplementary Criterion

Admissions criteria for entry September 2024

In the event of over-subscription within any one of the above criteria, the following sub-criterion will be applied:

 Children whose home is closest to Meadow Bridge, measured by the most direct route by road on Google Maps, will be given priority.

In the event that a Google Maps measurement is not available for a newly built house the closest listed address will be used to assist with measurement. This will be at the Board of Governors' discretion.

Tie Breaker Criterion

If two addresses with equal distance measurement qualify for the last available place, the last available place will be selected for admission on the basis of initial letter(s) of the surname (as entered on Birth Certificate) in the order set out below (determined by random selection):

IQRNFVMDSUCLKJZYOAEWGTXPMacHBMc

In the event of surnames beginning with the same initial letter the subsequent letters of the surname will be used in alphabetical order. In the event of two identical surnames the alphabetical order of the initials of the forenames will be used.

Duty to Verify

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine to support or verify information on any application.

If the requested evidence is not provided to the Board of Governors by the deadline given, this will result in the withdrawal of an offer of a place. Similarly, if information is supplied which appears to be false or misleading in any material way, the offer of a place will be withdrawn.

Waiting List Policy

Should a vacancy arise after the Open Enrolment Procedure concludes on 27 April 2024, all applications for admission to Year 1 at Meadow Bridge Primary School that were initially refused in the first instance will be given priority, followed by new applications, late applications and applications where new information has been provided, which will all be treated equally and the above criteria applied. This waiting list will be in place until the end of the 2024-2025 academic year.

The school will contact you if your child gains a place by this method. Your child's name will be automatically added to this list. Please contact the school if you wish for your child's name to be removed from the list.
